# STOCKLEY PARK – 13<sup>th</sup> April 2008

This was the first event I have organised for Irons and I was more than a bit concerned that things might go horribly wrong. I was sure I was going to forget to do something. Adrian sent the invitation out about three weeks before the day but after a week I only had six entrants. I could see this being a bit of a limited event. Unusually, the Society had arranged to play on two consecutive Sundays and I feared that several members had chosen to only play on one of them. However, more emails gradually turned up and eventually I had nineteen players.

One of my other duties for 2008 is to organise the annual Match play Competition. It had been decided to hold the draw at Stockley Park so I had two things to worry about on the day. The draw went successfully – I believe this was the first time we've held the draw at an event and it allowed everyone to see the pairings being drawn. I think we should do this in future as it adds more interest to the competition.

I had been warned that Stockley Park were having a driving range built and that a couple of holes had been rearranged to accommodate it but I wasn't expecting to see the mountain of earth that was covering the front half of the old 1<sup>st</sup> fairway. The beautiful pond that used to exist between the 9<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> pins had been filled in although apparently it will be extended and refilled with water later. I have never seen so much GUR in my life – the area in front of the clubhouse was like a building site. The 1<sup>st</sup> had been shortened to a par 3 and its tee is now a fair walk from the clubhouse. It is planned to make the current 9<sup>th</sup> hole into the 18<sup>th</sup> with a new 9<sup>th</sup> being created. The present 18<sup>th</sup> will become the practice green.

Last time we played at Stockley only about half of us finished with many giving up after the first nine because it had been pouring down since the first tee and much of the course was waterlogged following several days of rain. I didn't expect it to be as bad this time although the showers that were forecast turned out to be a bit more than showers.

We were pleased to welcome Neil W as a new member to the club with a handicap of 19. I deliberately put him in one of the later tee slots as I know from experience that it can be a terrifying experience for a newcomer to have a gallery of about twenty people watching you tee off!

For some reason, the club pro asked us to start on the 14<sup>th</sup> which is near the clubhouse. We all got away on time: five three-balls and one four-ball. I was in the four-ball at the back with Neil W, Melissa C. and Kevin D. We got a lot of black looks when we got back to clubhouse because everyone claimed we had been slow and they'd been waiting for us for ages. I don't think we were slow at all; the five three-balls in front of us were too fast! We did get held up though by a single ball who came up behind us: we let him through and then he duffed every shot on the hole. At one stage there were five of us on the green!
